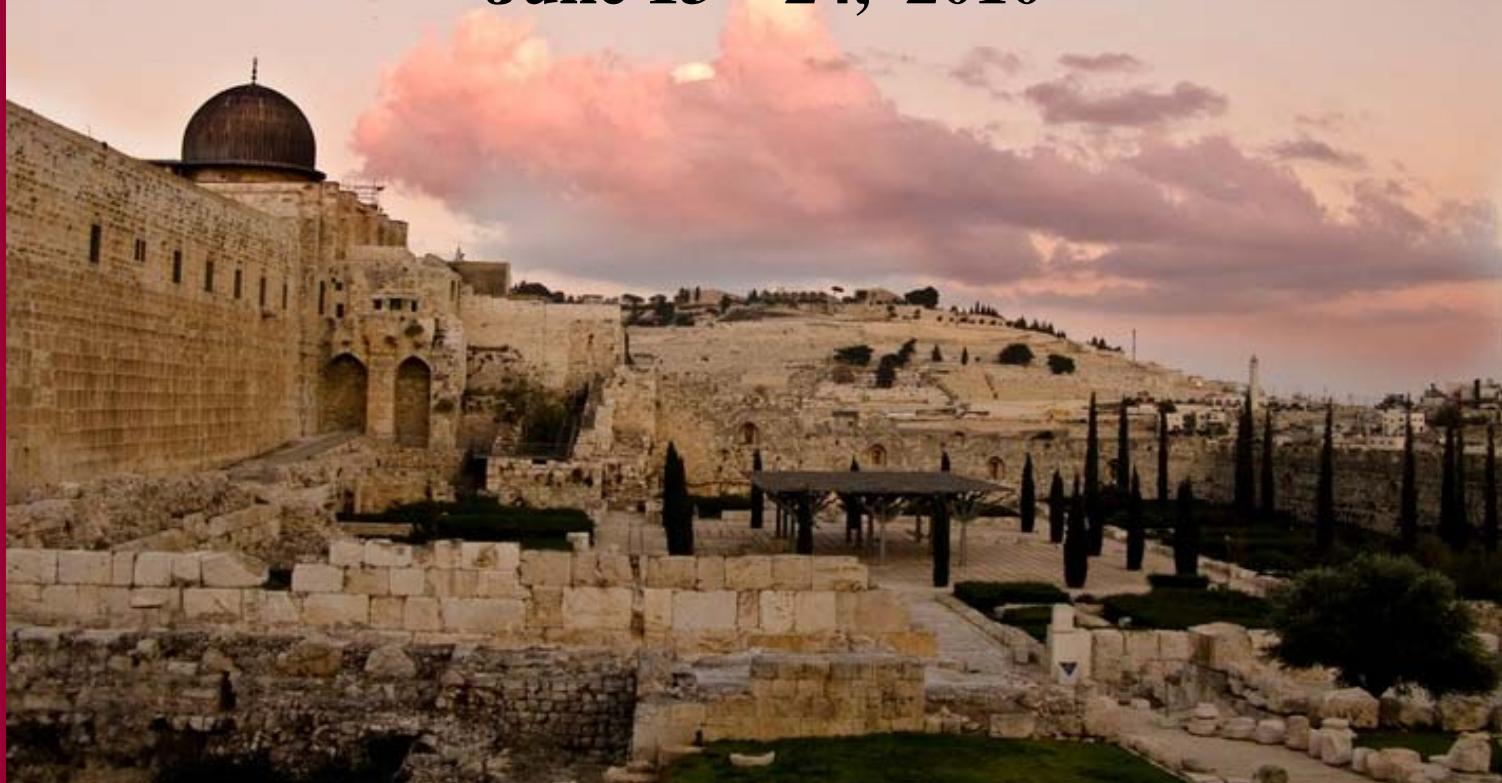

DAILY ITINERARY



DAY 01: BEGINNING OUR EXPLORING TOUR Depart USA to board your International flight to Amman, Jordan via jet service.

DAY 02: INTO THE LAND OF THE BIBLE Arrive in Amman. Our agent will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Amman.

DAY 03 PETRA, THE RED ROCK CITY This morning, depart Amman to visit Petra, the Red Rock City. It is considered the

Eighth Wonder of the World, a complete city carved in colored sandstone, rediscovered in 1812. An unforgettable experience on horseback or chariots through a narrow canyon, you will enter the Nabatean city of Petra to visit the Treasury, the theater, the Palace of Justice and other marvels. Return to your hotel in Amman for dinner and overnight.

DAY 04: AMMAN/MT. NEBO/ISRAEL This morning we will start our journey into the Promised Land by driving to Mt. Nebo. Drive along the same route, Prophet Moses was forbidden to travel by the King of Edom (Numbers 20), Picture yourself standing where Moses was laid to rest. Visit the memorial of Moses, the presumed site of his death and burial place, which is center for pilgrimages since the earliest Christian times. You will be inspired by the Biblical feel from start to finish as you experience this divine tour. Continue to the border crossing. After the brief border formalities we will drive along the shores of the Dead Sea. Dinner and overnight at the Dead Sea

DAY 05: DEAD SEA/ QUMRAN / MASADA This morning drive into the wilderness of Judea to visit Qumran, the site where the Scrolls of the Dead Sea were found by a shepherd boy. Continue on a beautiful new road that takes you along the shores of the Dead Sea to Ein Gedi where a precipitous cliff, filled with caves, rises some 2,000 feet. Enough time is provided to visit the Waterfalls of Ein Gedi. Continue on to Masada where the Zealots held the last foothold before they sacrificed their lives for their liberties. The ruins of the Roman Camps are still surrounding the fortress and the ruins speak to the visitors about the Glory of Masada and of Herod's works. Return to your hotel for an afternoon of relaxation and maybe you will choose to enjoy a rub down with the rich minerals of the Dead Sea at the facilities of the Spa in your hotel.

DAY 06: ALONG THE JORDAN VALLEY Leave the Dead Sea and Proceed along the Jordan Valley to Jericho and Tel El Sultan, ruins of one of the oldest cities in the world. View the Mount of Temptation, where Jesus fasted for 40 days and 40 nights. Visit Elisha's Fountain. Continue along the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean, a historic city. During the reign of Saul, the city was occupied by the Philistines. Excavations have uncovered eighteen layers of habitation in Beit Shean. The Roman Amphitheater is the best preserved in Israel, Today we will finish our journey with a dinner and an overnight at our luxurious hotel along the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 07: GALILEE & UPPER GALILEE This morning board a boat on the calm surface of the sea, cruising toward Capernaum. Upon landing, visit the site where Jesus started His Ministry and

the house of Peter and the Synagogue where Jesus was teaching. Continue to Tabgha, the site of the Multiplication of Loaves and Fish. See the 4th century mosaics. Drive to the top of the Mount of Beatitudes overlooking the Sea and surrounding area. In the afternoon drive to the Golan Heights in Upper Galilee. Visit the Sources of the Jordan River, Caesarea Philippi at the Baniyas, view Tel Dan. Return to the exit of the Jordan River from the Sea of Galilee where a Baptismal Service can be arranged. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 08: ALL THE PAST YEARS WITH HISTORY Drive to Cana to visit the site where the first miracle took place. Continue to Nazareth to visit Mary's Well and the Church of the Annunciation, built in 1960-68 enclosing the crypt, which is one of the largest Christian sanctuaries in the Middle East. After our visit in Nazareth we will proceed to Megiddo, (Armageddon) a very important strategic point on the Via Maris connecting Egypt and Damascus. Continue to Haifa and see Elijah's Cave and enjoy the view of the city from Mt. Carmel. We will drive along the shores of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea; visit the ruins of the Crusader's City. Visit the Roman Theater, Proceed to the city of Bethlehem for our dinner and overnight.

DAY 09: THE MOUNTAINS OF JERUSALEM AND BETHLEHEM This morning we visit the Church of Nativity, Shepherds Field and the Field of Boaz and Ruth. Drive to the Mount of Olives with its outstanding view of the city. Visit the Chapel of Ascension, Church of Pater Noster, Garden of Gethsemane, Church of All Nations. View the Kidron Valley. Visit Mount Zion, the site where Jesus accomplished His Ministry. Visit the room of the Last Supper. Visit the Tomb of King David and the House of Caiaphas Drive to the Knesset, or the House of Parliament. Visit the Shrine of the Book enclosing the Scrolls of the Dead Sea. Visit the model of Jerusalem as it was laid out at the time of Christ. Return to your hotel.

DAY 10: JERUSALEM, THE HOLY CITY Visit the Garden Tomb and Gordon's Calvary, the site where Jesus was crucified, buried, and resurrected. A service can be arranged at the Garden Tomb. Proceed towards the city walls built by Sulieman the Magnificent enclosing the most Holy sites. Walk into the old city through Damascus Gate and through the picturesque colorful bazaars to the superb Temple Area, where Solomon's Temple was built on Mount Moriah. Visit the Dome of the Rock enclosing the Rock of Sacrifice; the Mosque of Al Aksa and further south, the Pinnacle of the Temple and the Western Wall or the Wailing Wall. In the afternoon, start at Saint Stephen's Gate and back into the Old City to visit the Church of Saint Anne, the Pool of Bethesda, the Lithostrotos, Pilate's Judgment Hall and walk on the Via Dolorosa leading us to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Walk through the bazaars to the Citadel and take the bus from Jaffa Gate. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight

DAY 11: We avoid the "wake up in the middle of the night" to take an "early flight" out of the Holyland in order to make connections in Europe for our flight home. Instead, we have a bonus morning in the Holyland before catching a late afternoon flight to Paris where we will enjoy "an evening in Paris with dinner".

Day 12: This morning, after breakfast, we will transfer to the Charles De Gaulle International Airport for our flight back home.

AIR: HOU/CDG/AMM-TLV/CDG/HOU Seasonal Super Apex. Prices are based on fares as of July 30, 2009, and subject to change without prior notice.

GROUND: Deluxe air-conditioned motor coaches.

HOTELS: Deluxe Hotels & SUPERIOR First class hotels throughout. Limited number of single rooms are available at regular supplement. Rooms will be requested but are not to be considered confirmed until actual confirmations are received.

MEALS: 2 MEALS PER DAY: Full buffet breakfast and dinner daily.

TRANSFERS: Deluxe Air-conditioned / Heated motor coaches.

NOTE: All supplements in connection with early, late and/or weekend transfers are included throughout.

SIGHTSEEING: As and wherever indicated in the itinerary, including the services of English speaking guides as well entrance fees to all places of interest listed in your itinerary
